Joining the WhatsApp Community

Conference Schedule

The conference schedule will be posted in the WhatsApp community group. The schedule is set in Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +0). Please use a time converter or AI tools to convert the times to your own local time zone. Keep an eye out for updates and notifications, and make sure to note down the timings so you don't miss any sessions!

Zoom Link and Access

All sessions will take place on Zoom. The Zoom link for each session will be announced one hour before the start of the conference in the WhatsApp group. This helps ensure the security of our conference. Log in a few minutes early to settle in and be ready to participate.

Allocations and Preparation

All country and committee allocations have been made through MyMUN. If you're unsure about your allocation, you can check it on the MyMUN platform. This will help you prepare effectively for your committee sessions. Remember to research your country's stance on the topics provided and come prepared to debate!

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Online Orientation

The chairs of each committee will organize an online orientation session for all delegates. This session will provide an overview of what to expect and how to prepare for your committee. While attendance is not mandatory, it is highly encouraged as it will help you feel more confident and prepared for the conference.

Attendance and Certificates

To be eligible for a certificate of participation, you need to attend and actively participate in at least 3 out of the 4 sessions. Certificates for those who meet this requirement, as well as for awardees, will be sent in the WhatsApp community within 3 weeks after the conference. We highly encourage you to attend all sessions to gain the full experience.

Technical Requirements and Setup

To ensure a smooth experience, please make sure you have the following:

- **Stable Internet Connection:** A reliable internet connection is essential to avoid disruptions during the conference.
- **Device Preparation:** We recommend using a computer or laptop rather than a mobile device to fully access all conference features.
- **Testing Zoom and MyMUN Access:** Please test your Zoom and MyMUN access prior to the conference to resolve any technical issues ahead of time.
- **Background Preparation:** We highly recommend all of the delegates to have our Zoom background picture posted in our WhatsApp community.
