GUIDELINES FOR POSITION PAPERS

As part of your participation in DLMUN-Hosted Conferences, you are required to submit position papers for each topic assigned to your committee. Here are some concise guidelines to help you prepare your papers:

1. Introduction:

- a. Begin with a brief introduction of your country and its relevance to the committee's topics.
- b. State your country's stance on each topic.

2. Background:

- a. Provide a summary of the issue at hand.
- b. Include relevant historical context and key events that have shaped the current situation.

3. Country's Position:

- a. Clearly outline your country's position on the topic.
- b. Mention any national policies, past actions, and statements by government officials related to the issue.

4. Proposed Solutions:

- c. Margins: 1 inch on all sides.
- d. Line Spacing: Double-spaced.
